We are very excited to see progress on our new Op-Shop with the internal renovation 90% complete.

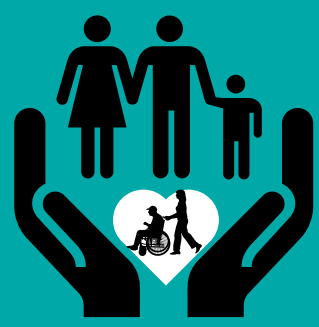
The new shop will have more capacity to display donated goods which will mean more funding for our other services eg: Counselling, Social Work, Budgeting

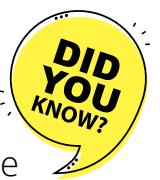
