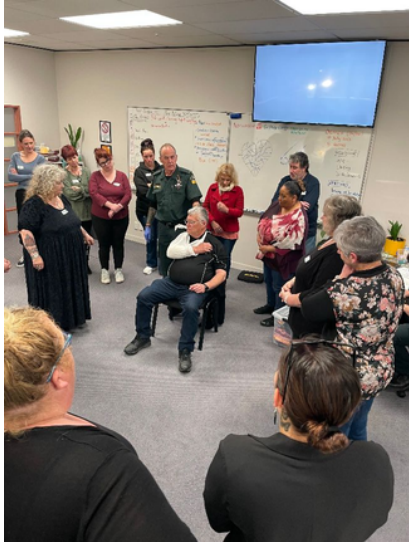


VTNZ (New Zealand vehicle inspection company) are now working from Manchester House to conduct restricted and full license testing.

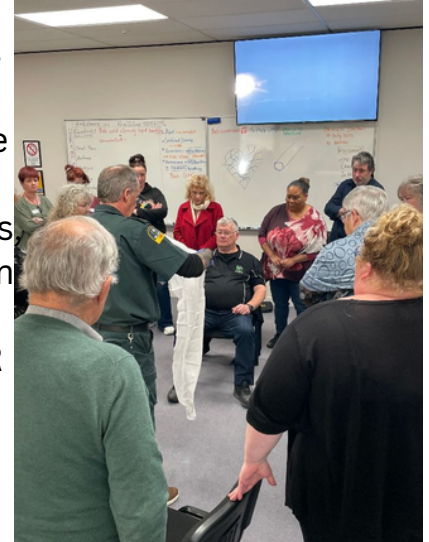




First aid Course
