Matariki - signifies reflection, hope and our connection to the environment

Pōhutukawa - connects with those who have passed on Waitī - ties to bodies of fresh water and the food within it Waitā - ties to the ocean and the food within it Waipuna-ā-rangi - associated with the rain Tupuānuku - is for food that grows within the soil Tupuārangi - is for food that grows up in the trees Ururangi - is the star associated with the winds
